

Bridgeton ordinances contain various regulations. A zoning approval is needed for any building, property changes, building a fence, property clearings, large excavations. BEFORE construction, permits, or questions, Please contact BRYAN KOLK 616-780-5751 *All Bridgeton Township ordinances are located at County Clerk's Office, Fremont, and Grant Library* **Camping Ordinance** A friendly reminder that our Township has a camping ordinance. Camping on a parcel of property that extends past 4 days per year must obtain a permit. Contact our Zoning Administrator for a permit or questions. **Cemetery** Ordinance Our Township has a cemetery ordinance that is being enforced. A complete set of ordinances are posted in two places in the cemetery and are available upon request. No glass, food, or balloons, they will be removed. Junk Ordinance Our Township has a junk ordinance. The Township offers FREE spring and fall clean-up days. We highly encourage property owners/renters to take advantage of these events.


